
Stage 1 1700 – Port Royal (Geo-Political)

- POLITICAL Viewed from London, buccaneering
 was a low-budget way to wage war on England's
 rival, Spain. So, the English crown licensed
 buccaneers with letters of marque legalizing their
 operations in return for a share of their profits
- LOGISTICS HUB Centre of commerce, shipping; exchange of value; ship repairs; careening; provisioning; storage; temporary accommodation (Toursim); housing; medical services.










South Hampton Transshipment Port




